

ATTENTION COMMUNITY MEMBERS REQUIRING Department of Lands & Natural Resources Service (Land transfers and Estate Administration)

As a precautionary measure of the COVID-19 virus, the Department of Lands & Natural Resources would like to have your cooperation in the measures we have identified below to ensure that we all do our part to limit any potential transfer of the virus due to an individual unknowingly carrying the virus.

DO NOT ATTEND OUR OFFICE IF:

- you have traveled:
 - out of country in the last 14 days, or
 - have been in contact with a sick traveler in the last 14 days or
 - attended or have been in contact with someone who attended the Prospectors & Developers Association of Canada Conference in Toronto on March 3-5

AND

You have the following new symptoms

- Fever or Cough or Shortness of Breath

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS, WE STILL REQUIRE YOU TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- disinfect your hands with the PURELL hand sanitizer that is located at the door entrance
- attending visitor will only be allowed to the table at the main entrance
- try to maintain a 6 foot distance between the staff you are conducting services with
- utilize the provided pen for signature purposes (pens are wiped after each visit)

Unfortunately, only visits for land transfers or Estate administration services will be allowed in the office until further notification.
