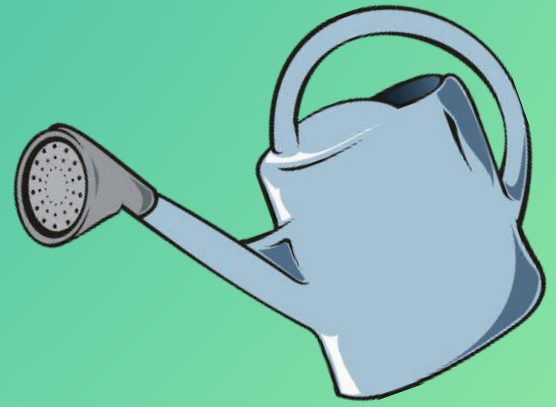
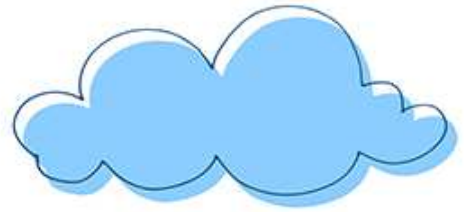
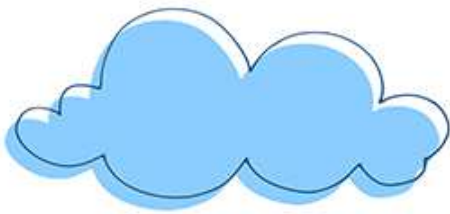

# Conserving Water

Potable water consumption requires energy to take source water. More energy is required for the treatment and storage of safe drinking water for distribution throughout Wiikwemkoong. Reducing potable water consumption provides a net benefit for Wiikwemkoong, our neighbors and the global community in general by limiting potential pollutants to Wikwemkoong's source water.

Conserving water and energy is very important for our environment. We can conserve our water usage by:

- Taking shorter showers.
- Report and/or repair leaky plumbing.
- Limit how often you wash dishes or how often you use your dishwasher.
- Don't let your water run.
- Reuse water that you used to boil your vegetables, to feed your plants.
- Collect rain water.
