Community Support Services Available to Assist Individuals Affected by Recent Charge

WIIKWEMKOONG - Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory (WUT) and Kina Gbezhgomi Child & Family Services (KGCFS) recognize the importance of coming together as a community to provide assistance and comfort to those who may be affected by a past event that has recently come to light.

On April 8, 2024, Greater Sudbury Police Service (GSPS) charged a 57-year-old male of Sudbury with Sexual Assault under the Criminal Code of Canada. GSPS advised that the incident occurred in 1999 and involved a 15-year-old youth who was a ward of the Children's Aid Society (CAS) Sudbury & Manitoulin. The accused was a former employee of the CAS Sudbury & Manitoulin who will appear in court on May 1, 2024, to answer to the charges.

Due to the recent release of such a sensitive and traumatic event, we want to extend our heartfelt support to the community.

As a reminder, Crisis Support Services are available to all Wiikwemkoong Band Members at any time. Based on the GSPS investigation, the police are concerned there may be more victims.
