DUTIES:

- To learn, share and engage with visitors about the Anishinaabe Culture, language and history on Manitoulin Island and Killarney.
- To deliver all tours including individual, group, motor coach and Familiarization tours in a safe, respectful, and authentic manner that is aligned with Anishinaabe Bimaadzwini.
- Participate in Cultural Guide Training inclusive of Traditional Anishnaabe Knowledge and industry related training
- Assist with maintaining tourism assets, spaces, supplies, and equipment including canoes, hiking trails, and historic sites
- Forage for natural ingredients and other natural materials for Cultural experiences.
- Ensure that all necessary and relevant documentation is completed by guests and maintain customer evaluations for reporting purposes.
- Assist with developing new Tourism products and/or enhance existing products
- Assist with tourism related events
- Deliver superior customer service and model service excellence delivery with Tourism Ambassadors and guests.
- Working in compliance with the Occupation Health and Safety Act and its Regulations and any workplace practices as directed by the employer
- Perform other assigned duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be registered with an Anishinaabe community.
- Knowledge of and or willing to learn about Anishinabek history, language and cultural practices.
